• The audition fee is \$15.00 per audition. (If you wish to take 2 auditions, you must pay \$30.) You must pay for all auditions before Mr. Lehde will register you. You can pay via Myschoolbucks.com or a check to "Ladue Bands"

AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS

- Plan to arrive at Clayton High School 30 minutes before your assigned audition time.
- PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE AT Clayton High School BEFORE 4:00 pm unless you have a 4:30 audition time. 4:30 auditionees may show up at 4:00 pm.
- You will be met at your audition room by a room monitor who will double check with you as to your audition time and confirm your name. This information will not be made available to the judge.
- Audition times and room assignments will be EMAILED to band directors by the end of the week of October 18.
- Report to your audition room 10 minutes prior to your audition. The room monitor will call you by your audition time when it is your time to audition.
- Avoid talking to the judge. If you have any questions, ask the room monitor.
- Failure to report to your audition at your assigned time may result in you not being able to audition.

AUDITION MATERIAL

- Scales (for Concert Band auditions) are listed in CONCERT PITCH and do not need to be memorized. Concert C, F, Bb, Eb, Ab, and Chromatic 2 octaves if possible (no scales required for percussion). Please see scale sheets for suggested scale ranges.
- Concert Band audition etudes are from the rotating audition sets adopted in 1998. This year we will use SET #1.
- Percussion auditions...All students must bring their own snare drum. Timpani will be provided and they will already be tuned. A set of bells, a xylophone, and a marimba will be available to accommodate the instrument that the students most practice on their own. Vibes will not be available because they will be used for Jazz auditions at the same time.
- Sight-reading (4-8 measures) for all wind instruments. Percussion sight-reads on snare drum.
- REMINDER –In order to keep auditions flowing smoothly and quickly, students may only be asked to play sections of the etudes. Students should, however, prepare all etudes in their entirety. Sight reading examples will be at about the same difficulty level as the prepared etudes.
